SOP for Inter-Sector Sports Tournaments 2025-26

1. Instructions:

1. **Only regular employees** (no contractual or tenure based) are eligible to participate in the Inter-sector sports tournaments.
2. **An employee can participate in maximum 2 sports for Sectoral trials.**
3. **An employee can participate in only 1 sport in Inter-Sector tournament.**
4. The playing kits for the team shall be procured by the WorkCentre, **as per point No. 2 below (Table 1)**. Funds for the same shall be provided by CSD. No personal playing equipment will be provided to the participants.
5. Head/ In-charge HR/ER designated for conducting the Intra-Sectoral trials shall decide the modalities of conducting such trials and select a team. On completion of the process the details of the selected team shall be communicated to Corporate Sports Division (ongcsports@ongc.co.in).
6. **Head Corporate Sports will finalize the dates of the tournament in consultation with the HR Head of the designated WorkCentre's.** Dates of tournament shall be intimated by the host WorkCentre well in advance through circulation in OR net.
7. **Active sportspersons** recruited under sports quota shall not participate in any of the events.
8. **Decategorised sportspersons** below the age of 45 years shall also not participate in any Inter-sector tournament. However, decategorised players above the age of 45 years may participate in sports except for the sports under which they were recruited.
9. Selection trials at WorkCentre / sector level to be conducted only on Saturday, Sunday & adjoining Holidays.
10. Inter Sector tournaments will be held preferably on Saturday, Sunday & adjoining Holidays.
11. No additional official (Manager / Coach) will accompany the team for Sectoral trials / Inter-sector games. A senior player of the team can be designated as Manager / Team Coordinator.
12. Each sector will be allowed to field only one team.
